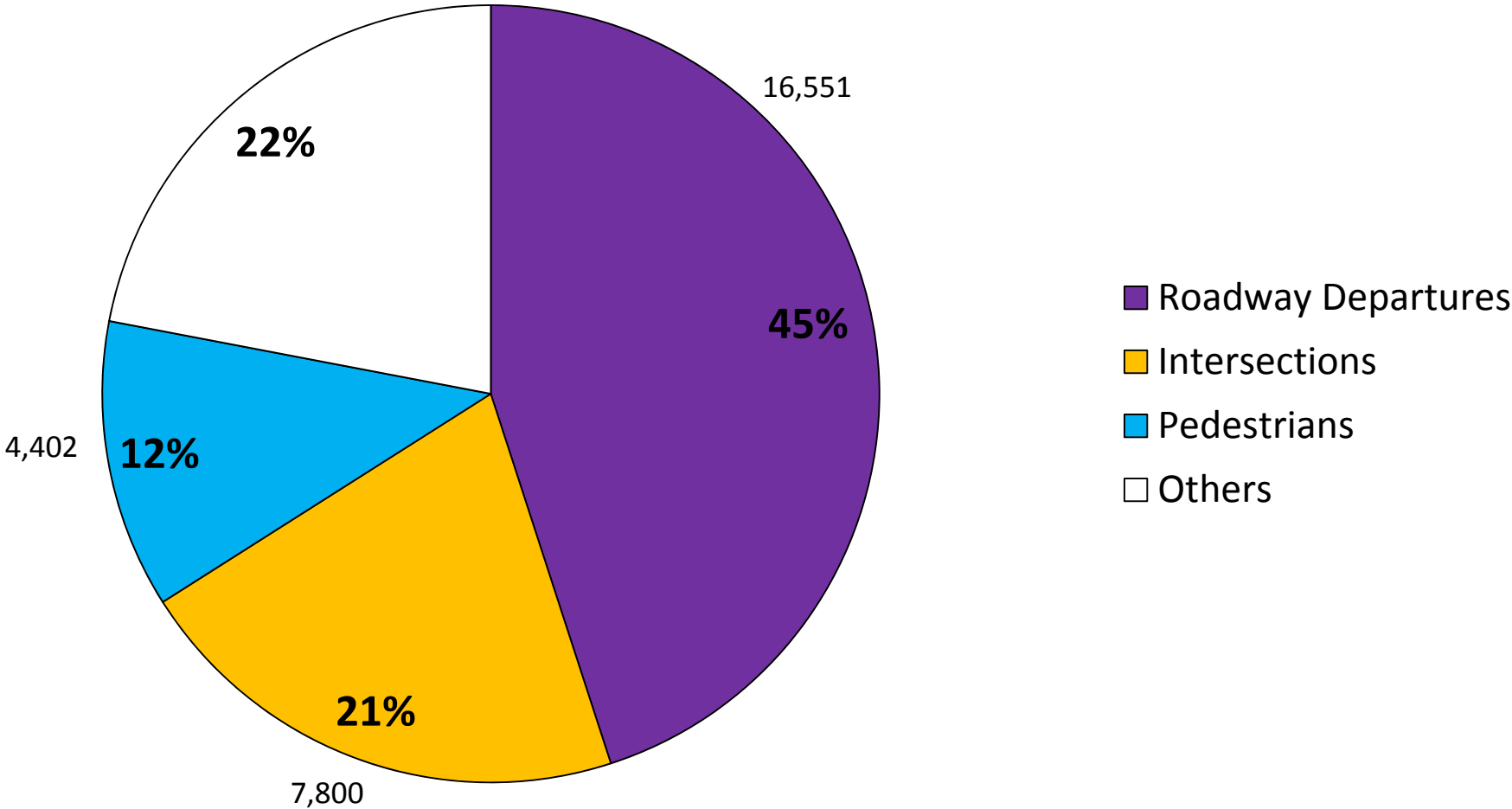

Roundabouts	Longitudinal rumble strips and stripes on two lane roads	Medians and pedestrian crossing islands in urban and suburban areas
Corridor access management	Enhanced delineation and friction for horizontal curves	Pedestrian hybrid beacon
Backplates with retroreflective borders	Safety Edge	Road diet
